**Getting Started**

- **When has doing the right thing cost you?**
- **What shapes us more. Easy times, or difficult ones? Why?**

**Digging Deeper**

- **Who are some people in the Bible that were put in difficult situations?**
  - **What did they go through? How did they get through it?**
  - **How did they keep their eyes on God and his plan?**
- **Despite being dealt a terrible hand(sold by his brothers and being someone else's property), Joseph flourished while in Potiphar's house.**
  - **What can we learn from this?**
  - **How did Joseph respond to the temptation from Potiphar's wife? Did she tempt him once? (Genesis 39-6-10)**
- **Liberty does not equal license. (1 Corinthians 10:23)**
  - **Joseph could have given into temptation, why do you think he resisted?**
- **Everything is spiritual.**
  - **Joseph said he did not want to commit a sin to God. Why didn't he say Pharaoh?**
- **Don't set yourself up.**
  - **It is probable that Potiphar's wife put Joseph in a situation where it would be harder for him to say no. Why is it important that we should be diligent to not put ourselves in situations where it's easy to give in to temptation?**
- **Throughout this chapter the phrase "The Lord was with Joseph." is repeated.**
  - **What do you think the author is emphasizing?**
  - **Was the Lord with Joseph only in times of flourishing?**
  - **Why is it easy to forget this when we're facing difficulties?**
